

Summer Riding Program at The Southlands Foundation



The Southlands Summer Riding Program, started in the early 1940's, combines qualified staff, experienced horses, and impressive facilities to create an experience of a lifetime! We offer sessions for beginners through advanced riders and assign each participant a horse or pony of their own to ride and care for. Through each rider's daily responsibilities, participants learn the basics of good horsemanship, make lasting friendships and gain independence and confidence!

This year's Summer Riding Program will be split into two sections, a **Young Rider Camp** and a **Junior Rider Camp**.

Young Rider Camp is a new Southlands program that grows from our very popular "Green Camp". This new program will move at a slower pace than our Junior Rider Camp and will allow our lessons to cater to our growing crowds of beginner, walk/trot, and timid riders (ages 5 and up). Young Rider Camp will run in two sessions. Campers are encouraged to complete the entire session or both. A session is designed for the optimum growth of each rider. Each week builds on each other, both in riding and horsemanship skills. Riders who participate in both sessions will find themselves in a higher level lesson by session II!

Junior Rider Camp is geared towards riders ages 8 and up who are secure at the canter. Both mounted and unmounted activities work towards total understanding of proper horsemanship, with the ultimate goal of owning and providing care for one's own pony or horse. Our Junior Rider Camp will run in two week sessions. This extended camp time allows riders to obtain goals over a more realistic time period. Of course, single weeks may still be attended. During Junior Rider Camp riders will be able to sign up weekly for special events ranging from trail rides and dressage lessons to cross country schooling sessions. During each day of camp, lessons will be available for those just mastering crossrails to those jumping 3 ft courses!
